Pre-Operative & Post-Operative
Care Instructions



Before Surgery

- 1. Pick up prescription for antibiotic ointment before surgery. After surgery, apply a thin film across the stitches 3x day. It's okay if ointment gets into your eyes, however it will blur your vision. If it's too bothersome, you may apply it only at bedtime.
- 2. Stop blood thinning medicines and supplements seven to ten days before the surgery with permission from your primary care doctor. You may resume 3 days after surgery.
- **3.** Arrange for a ride home after surgery, as you will not be able to drive for 24 hours.
- 4. Bromelain is an enzyme contained in pineapple that lessens the time and amount of bruising. If desired, consume 1/4 to 1/3 of a fresh pineapple daily, to limit bruising. Begin eating fresh pineapple 3-4 days before surgery and continue until bruising and swelling has dissipated. If you don't like pineapple, you can purchase Bromelain in a supplement form at many local stores. It is not beneficial to do both.

Day of Surgery

- 1. Apply ice to lids at least 15 minutes every waking hour for the first 24 hours after surgery. Ice may be in the form of crushed ice, frozen peas/corn, or refreezable ice packs. Always have a moist, clean cloth between the ice and your skin.
- 2. Expect some oozing of blood through the wounds for the first 24 hours. If bleeding occurs, place a clean, wet cloth over the area and hold constant pressure for ten minutes. If bleeding persists, call Dr. Sneed at 231-947-6246 or 231-935-5000.
- 3. Sutures are fragile do not rub or pull loose ends.
- **4.** Tylenol, or Extra Strength Tylenol as needed for discomfort. If pain is intolerable, call Dr. Sneed.

After Surgery

- You must have someone drive you home after surgery.
- Decreasing vision, persistent bleeding, increasing pain and extreme swelling are unusual symptoms.
 If any of these occur, call:

- Expect to be bruised and swollen for at least 2 weeks.
- Time off work is a personal choice but not necessary.
- Avoid swimming and/or hot tub use for two weeks after procedure. Showering is fine.
- Use artificial tears four times a day if eyes feel irritated.
- Avoid swimming and/or hot tub use for two weeks after surgery. Showering is fine. You may resume make up on eyelids (along the suture line) 2 days after sutures are removed.
- Resume non-strenuous, normal daily activity as desired.
